HEAR! Jesus is going to suffer death, and He will rise, but the disciples did not really understand what He was talking about. Sometimes we can also act that way.

Jesus' directions in the second part of the Gospel are pretty clear. "If anyone wishes to be first, he shall be the last of all and the servant of all." Serving others is what we are expected to do. But sometimes we are like the disciples: we just don't get it! Reflect on your actions of the past few days.

Were there times when you clearly acted as a servant? Were there times when you did not? What can you do in the days ahead to serve in a better way?

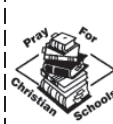

At week sixteen [16] in the Second Trimester of a baby's development in the womb of the mother, the baby becomes large enough and active enough for the mother to feel the child's movement. 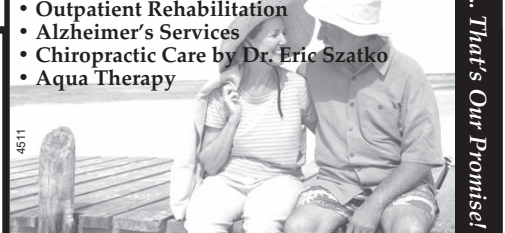
