

What is the meaning of the presentation of Jesus in the Temple? The Presentation of Jesus in the Temple is a Christian event that symbolizes Jesus' divine identity, his humanity, and the importance of community. It also represents the fulfillment of the Old Covenant and the Jewish Messiah's promise. The Presentation shows Mary and Joseph's cooperation with Jesus' divine mission and also reminds us of the importance of community. The Presentation shows how Jesus fulfills the Old Covenant by being consecrated to the Lord. The Presentation is celebrated on February 2nd, also known as Candlemas. This is because it takes place forty days after the nativity. Mary and Joseph take Jesus to the Temple to present him to the Lord. They offer a sacrifice of turtledoves or two young pigeons and Simeon and Anna recognize Jesus as the Son of God.

This weekend we also celebrate the Feast of St. Blaise, which falls on February 3, 2025. On the Feast Day of St. Blaise, the Church recalls a miracle cure associated with him and celebrates the blessing of the throats with candles. St. Blaise is a bishop and martyr who lived in the fourth century in Turkey and Armenia. For a time, Blaise lived in a cave to escape persecution. On his feast the church recalls a miracle cure associated with him and celebrates the blessing of the throats. Blaise apparently saved the life of a boy who was choking on a fish bone. The Saint said that anyone who lit a candle in his memory would be free of infection, thus candles are used in the traditional throat blessing. He is listed among the Fourteen Holy Helpers, saints revered as healers. He is the patron saint of throat illnesses, animals, wool combers, and wool trading. St. Blaise said that anyone who lit a candle in his memory would be free of infection, thus candles are used in the traditional throat blessing. The candles, blessed on Candlemas Feb. 2, are crossed against the throat, and the following prayer is said:

"Through the intercession of Saint Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from ailments of the throat and from every other evil. In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen."

Blessing of the throats will take place this weekend, February 1st & 2nd in honor of St. Blaise, who's feast day is February 3rd.

Please feel free to take a piece of straw from our manger and place it in your wallet. This will help make sure that you will not be hungry or without funds during this upcoming year.
