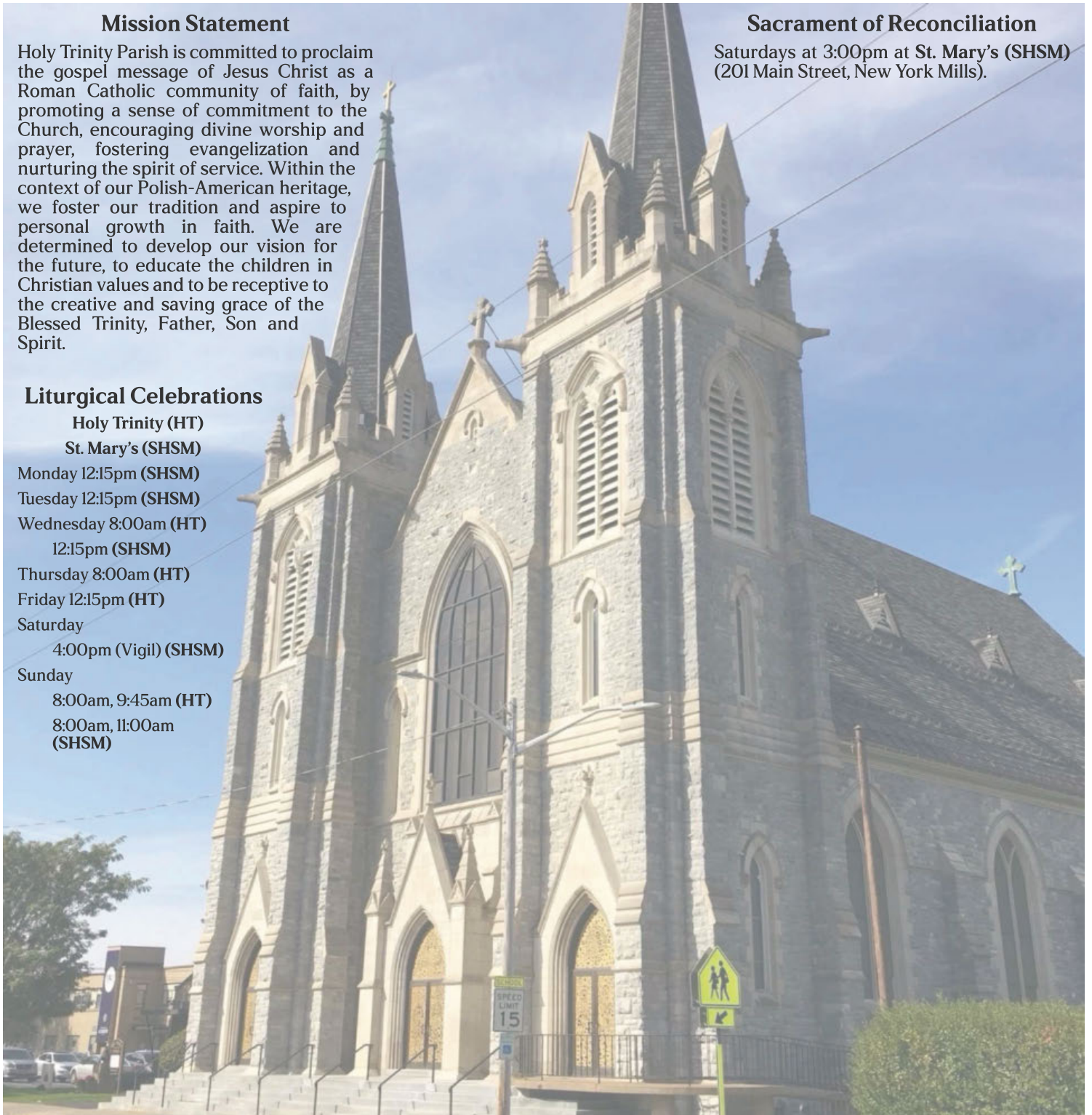

Good news! God has blessed Holy Trinity parish once again! We are pleased to report that Oneida Herkimer Madison BOCES has just approved a new 3 year lease extension of our Holy Trinity School building for the period starting July 1, 2025. The lease contains provisions for concurrent use of the gymnasium and kitchen for parish functions when school is not in session. The lease will assist parish finances and there will be some cost sharing such as utilities, snow plowing, mowing and other expenses. Thanks be to God that Holy Trinity has a stable long term tenant resulting in a mutually beneficial relationship.

As landlord, Holy Trinity will continue to have responsibility for maintenance and repair of the main plant structure. In an effort to protect our investment, our Building and Grounds Committee has embarked on a project to upgrade part of the school boiler system this summer. The current system is original (1959) and the project will result in better reliability and efficiency of the school heating system for years to come.

CALLED BY NAME: NURTURING VOCATIONS IN OUR PARISH AND DIOCESE

History was made recently with the election of Pope Leo XIV—the first American-born pope—whose vocation began in the parish pews of St. Mary of Assumption Church in Chicago. Raised in the life of the Church, he served as an altar boy, sang in the choir, and attended Catholic school, all of which helped form his call to serve. His story is a powerful reminder of how vital our parishes and schools are in helping young people hear and respond to God's call.

Here in the Diocese of Syracuse, we have reason to celebrate as well: this Saturday, two young men will be ordained to the priesthood at the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception. Their journey, like Pope Leo's, was shaped by the faith-filled communities around them. To continue this mission of nurturing future leaders in the Church, our diocese is once again launching the Called by Name initiative.

This program encourages parishioners and educators to prayerfully consider the young people in their midst who may be called to the priesthood, diaconate, or consecrated life. This weekend, parishes across the diocese will distribute nomination cards during all Masses, inviting you to write the name of someone who demonstrates the qualities of a future Church leader. Schools will do the same throughout this week, focusing on students in grades 8–12.

Nominations will be shared with the Diocesan Office of Vocation Promotion, and those nominated will receive a personal invitation to the Vocations Picnic with Bishop Lucia on Monday, August 4 at Immaculate Conception Parish in Fayetteville—an evening of fellowship, prayer, and discernment.

This initiative follows the recent celebration of the 62nd World Day of Prayer for Vocations, a global reminder to pray for more laborers for the Lord's harvest (Mt 9:38). Let us support vocations by actively participating in this year's Called by Name—a meaningful step in raising up the next generation of servant-leaders in our Church.

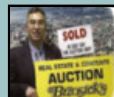
