

#### Theology Uncorked welcomes Rev. James J. Koury, M.T.S.

October 16, 2025, at 6:15 pm at Hart's Hill Inn. Rev. James will be speaking about "The Eastern Catholic Churches; an Overview". This talk will give a basic explanation of who the Eastern Catholic Churches are, why they exist, and some similarities and differences with their Orthodox Church counterparts. Ordained a priest in June 1992, Fr. Jim served parishes in the eparchies of Newton and Passaic while at the same time teaching theology and music on the elementary and secondary levels. In March of 2023, he was appointed pastor of St. Basil the Great Melkite Greek Catholic Church in Utica. Fr. Jim is a bi-ritual priest with the Roman (Latin) Church, meaning he can celebrate the sacraments in both the Byzantine and Roman rites.
